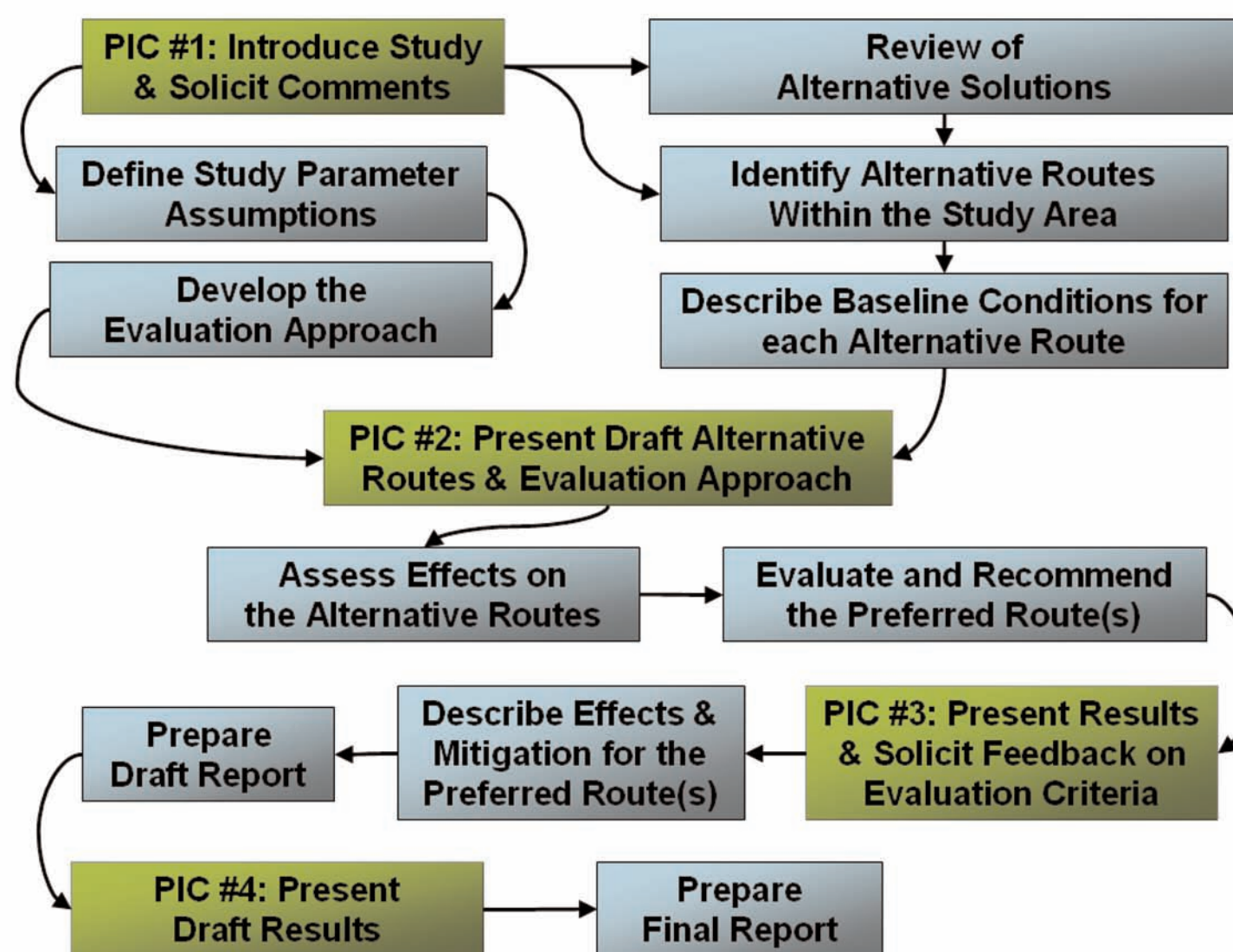


# Next Steps

Following tonight's **Public Information Centre #1**, all comments and feedback that are received will be compiled and reviewed by the study team.

Taking into consideration the feedback received, work will proceed on the study in accordance with the Terms of Reference. This diagram illustrates the key tasks, and the opportunities that will be made available for public consultation during the process. In addition to this public consultation, information will be circulated to, and meetings held with, the Agency Review Group as the study progresses.



At this time it is anticipated that the remaining Public Information Centres will be held as follows:

**Public Information Centre #2** will provide an opportunity to present the draft set of alternative haul routes, and the approach to be used to evaluate the routes.

**Public Information Centre #3** will allow for public input regarding the evaluation criteria to be used to select preferred routes, the relative importance of the criteria, and the approach to be used to apply the criteria.

**Public Information Centre #4** will be used to present the results of the comparative evaluation of the alternative routes, measures to mitigate impacts, and the impact assessment of the net effects of designating the preferred routes as quarry haul routes.

Following the final Public Information Centre, and prior to preparation of the final report, the draft report will be circulated to the Agency Review Group and made available to the public for final comments.
